- » Coordination and liaison with Purchasing and Procurement Agency and oversee installation when required
- » Coordinate and manage value engineering process when required
- » Site administration, visits, meetings, documentation of site progress and condition (some travel required)
- » Quality control of site work including Deficiency Reviews
- » Maintain construction standards with the Studio's CAD standard system and filing systems
